Flood Support Schemes For Homeowners And Businesses In Waverley

Waverley, in partnership with the Government, is offering financial support for homes and businesses that have been flooded since 1 December 2013. The Prime Minister recently announced a package of measures to be administered by local authorities and Waverley Borough Council intends to fully implement the proposed schemes.

Councillor Robert Knowles, Leader of the Council said “It is vital that we do all we can to help those affected by the recent flooding. We fully support the Government’s schemes and, whilst we don’t have all the details yet, we will do all we can to get financial assistance to those who suffered in the flooding as quickly as possible.”

The measures include 3-months council tax rebate for flooded homes and 3-months business rate relief for flooded businesses. Waverley will also bring in a business support scheme to help businesses that were flooded or directly affected by the flooding.

Waverley will also implement the Government’s repair and renewal grant scheme for properties that were flooded, which could provide assistance towards the costs of improving the property’s resilience or resistance to flooding in the future. We

are still awaiting final details of this scheme from the Government, but urge anyone who thinks that they may be eligible to contact us and register their interest so that we can get back to them when the scheme is finalised.

Applications for assistance under these schemes must be made using the forms included on our website at

www.waverley.gov.uk/floodsupport and must be received by the 30 April 2014. The application form explains what information we require in support of claims and includes contact details.
